The Fifth Annual OPEN AIR ART for OPEN SPACES  
“Working Properties”

Show Dates: May 2-7, 2010

Co-sponsored by Redlands Art Association and the Redlands Conservancy

All Plein Air artists are invited to paint on location at 8 sites listed below. These farms, ranches, groves and fruit stands represent the Redlands Conservancy's land trust goals of preserving and enhancing the agricultural heritage in and around Redlands. Resulting artworks are eligible for the Show-Within-A-Show at the Redlands Art Association gallery, 215 East Sate Street. Take-in on Saturday, May 1, 12-4. Maximum size, 24 inches in the longest dimension, including frame. Paintings must be dry, framed and securely wired for hanging. Entry fee is \$10 for the first entry and \$5 for each additional entry; maximum of 3 entries per artist. Art sales are handled through the Redlands Art Association, with 30% commission shared equally by the RAA and the RC. Reception and Awards Ceremony held at the RAA gallery on Sunday, May 2, from 2-4. Yvonne Branchflower will judge the show for cash prizes: \$150 for First Place, \$100 for Second, \$75 for Third as well as Honorable Mention ribbons. Artworks must remain on exhibit throughout the show dates and must be picked up on Saturday, May 8 from 10-2. All artwork exhibited must have been painted in April, 2010 at one of the locations listed below.

1. **IOC Grove Walk**, Saturday, April 3, 1-4. Inland Orange Conservancy sponsors this event, which includes a citrus tasting booth, citrus-related art and product booths, guided walks and viewings of antique farm equipment. Event is open to the public from 1-4. Artists should arrive at noon to be set up to paint before crowds arrive. Prospect Park, on the corner of Highland Ave. and Cajon St. Park along Highland Ave. or on East side of Cajon. Bathrooms available.

2. **IOC Packing House**, Wednesday, April 7, 8-12. This small packing house sits between plantings of Kiwi and Mandarines, with good views of mountains and other groves. Across from 206 Valencia. From Citrus Ave., turn South on Walnut St., then left on Valencia. Park near large Eucalyptus trees or across from 206 Valencia. Do not block dirt road leading to packing house. No bathrooms.

3. **Proud Horse Ranch**, Saturday, April 10, 9-1. Horses, burros, hills and trees to paint. Be considerate of horseback riders. 12854 San Timoteo Canyon Rd, 1/2 mile West from Allesandro Rd. on South side. Follow dirt road in: Park judiciously. No Bathrooms.

4. **The Farm at Grove School**, Wednesday, April 14, 9-1. Farm implements, goats, turkeys, llama and mountain views. From Redlands Blvd. turn South on Iowa St. (near Lowe's). Farmhouse is on corner of Iowa St. and Orange Ave. Park in dirt lot behind farmhouse. Bathrooms in farmhouse.

5. **Horseshoe Ranch**, Saturday, April 17, 9-1. Horses, longhorn cattle, stables, barns, hills. 30176 Live Oak Canyon Rd. From San Timoteo Canyon Rd., turn East on Wild Oak Canyon Rd. and go about 1 mile past the railroad Xing. Look for yellow sign on entry gate, drive up short distance and park on the right. Sign release slip before setting up. No Bathrooms.

6. **Redlands Foothill Groves Packing House**, Wednesday, April 21, 8-12. Last big packing house in San Brdo. Co., old building, crates, large trucks, Eucalyptus trees. 304 Ninth St., North of Redlands Blvd. Park on street, check in with one of us or at the office (center bldg. up steps). No Bathrooms.

7. **Artist's Choice of Fruit Stand**, Saturday, April 24, 8-12. Any working fruit stand in or near Redlands. If you don't have a favorite, contact Evelyn or Ginger for possible locations.

8. **Three Sisters Farm**, Tuesday, April 27, 9-1. Planted market garden, hills and canyon views. 30370 San Timoteo Canyon Rd., 1 1/2 miles East of Redlands-Moreno Blvd. On North side, white stucco straw bale house, no sign. No bathrooms.
