Drawing (ARTCS 131 IR01) 6/16/15 - 7/30/15

Instructor: Raymond Sloan

Location: Redlands: Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, 8:00am -12:00pmThis course covers the theory and practice of drawing using a variety of media and subject matter. Topics include drawing through the graphic elements of line, plane, tone, shape, form, volume, rendering, perspective, light and shadow. **(4 units)**

Introduction to Printmaking (ARTCS 155 IRO1) 6/16/15 – 7/30/15

The objective of this course is to introduce the beginning printmaker and to create a holistic knowledge of the basic technique as well. Topics include printmaking methods including intaglio, relief, monotype, and lithograph as well as technical concerns unique to printmaking including editioning, registering, collating, mixing inks, selecting paper, and press printing. Creative Photography (ARTCS 265 ON01) Online: 6/15/15 – 7/27/15 Instructor: Mel Johnson

This course is an introduction to the technical and conceptual practice of photography for artistic purposes. A range of aesthetic, technical, and conceptual applications within photography including artistic content development, documentary and reportage, portrait, still life photography and lighting will be explored. This is a studio art course that uses the computer as a tool to create visual images and implement design solutions. Solutions will be based in the foundations of 2 D design and principles of color theory are used to implement visual organization and communication. The student will learn to utilize digital media as an original reference source, as well as learning computer basics such as saving and organizing files, using different file formats, and optimizing files for print and web.
